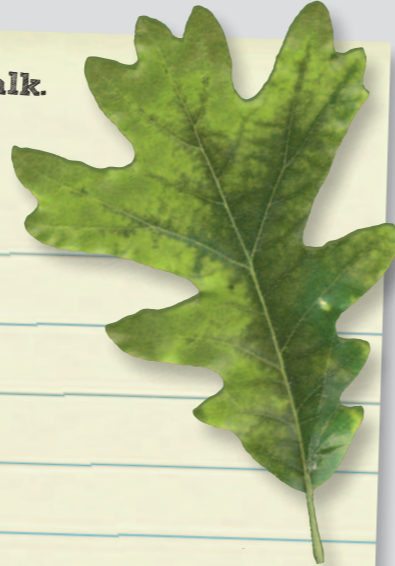


WILD SPACE GALLERY ACTIVITIES

Write them here.

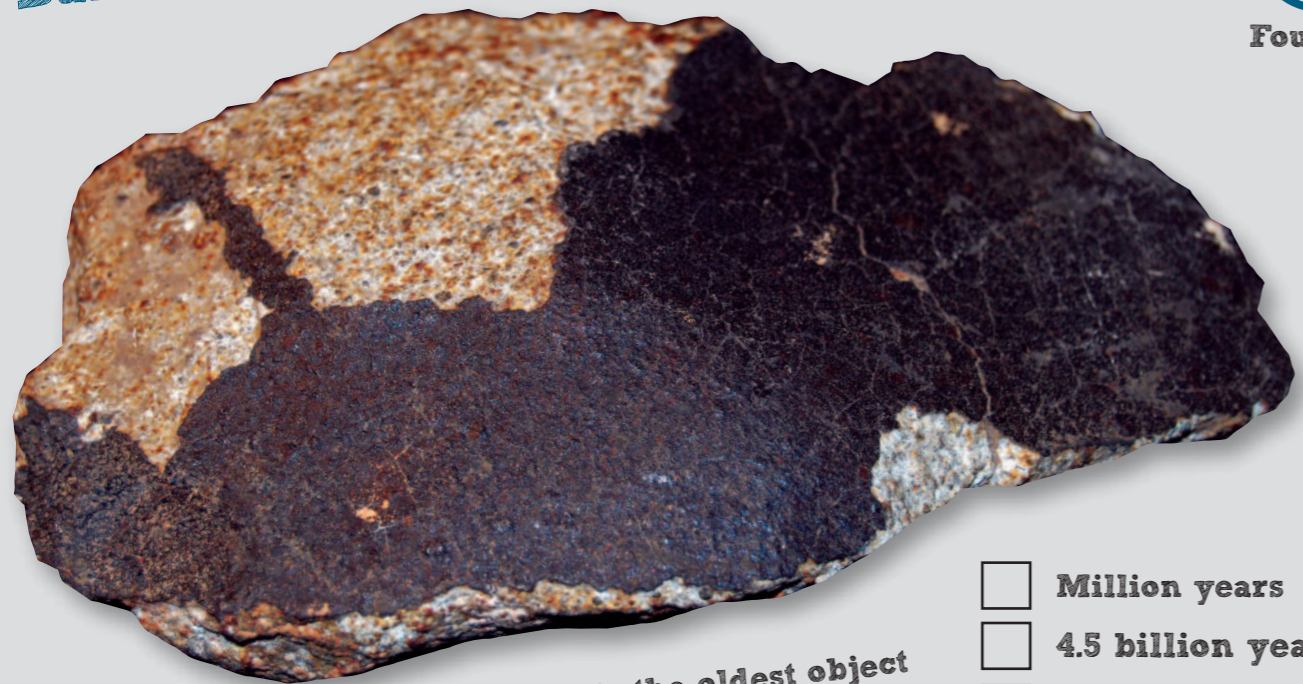
ROCKS & MINERALS GALLERY ACTIVITIES
