

THE RUTLAND DINOSAUR

The fossil bones of this dinosaur were found in a quarry near Rutland in 1968. The dinosaur had been buried for 168 million years. It is a *Cetiosaurus* (pronounced see-tee-oh -sore-rus) and belonged to a group called sauropods, or more commonly known as "brontosaurus".

This species have four strong legs, long necks, small heads and long tails. He was given his nickname of "Rutland the Dinosaur" from the county in which he was found.
