### **Discover a real Roman experience**



Leicester's rich Roman heritage is about to come alive like never before as Jewry Wall reopens on Saturday 26 July.

Following an extensive refurbishment, the museum will unveil an immersive, state-of-the-art exhibition that takes visitors on a journey through Roman Leicester, offering a unique blend of history, storytelling, and interactive experiences.

Jewry Wall is part of a 2nd Century Bath House and is one of Britain's largest surviving pieces of Roman masonry, standing as a testament to the grandeur of the ancient town of Ratae Corieltauvorum.

The museum adjacent to this remarkable site has been transformed into an exciting new attraction that brings history to life in an engaging and accessible way for visitors of all ages.

The reimagined Jewry Wall is a groundbreaking experience, placing storytelling at its heart. Visitors will be transported back almost 2,000 years through a mix of:

- Real stories of real Romans, brought vividly to life.
- Original artefacts unearthed right here in the city.
- Multimedia digital reconstructions of Roman Leicester.
- Active games and tactile exhibits for all ages.
- New café, gift shop, and welcoming spaces for learning and events. Perfect for families, history buffs, and curious minds alike.
