colour the leaf and flower garlands in, carefully cut out each piece and attach to a piece of string in a row to hang up as a Diwali decoration!




# \* Diwa Lamps \*


# Can Rama Find Sita?



Ravan, the 10 headed king of the demons, heard that Rama was in the forest. He wanted to fight him to prove his strength.




When Ravan got to the forest he saw beautiful Sita and came up with a sneaky plan to capture her.




He tricked Rama to chase after a golden deer. When Rama was gone Ravan stole Sita away!
